

NOTES FOR YOUR AT DOCK/SEA TRIAL

For power boat or sail boat use

Ensure all safety gear is onboard.		
Ensure fresh water tank has supply.		
Ensure the fuel level is sufficient.		
Plug the shore power cord in.		
Power up the hot water heater.		
Is there cold and hot water at the faucets?		
While running water look under the galley and head sinks for leaks.		
Does your VacuFlush head work as intended? If equipped		
Does your 12-volt DC head that uses lake water work as intended? If equipped		
Does your manual head that uses lake water work as intended? If equipped		
Add water to shower pan. Does the shower sump pump operate? If equipped		
Does the transom shower operate? If equipped		
Does the dock water hook up operate? If equipped		
Does the deck wash pump operate? If equipped		
Run the air system. Does it heat and cool? If equipped		
Are there propane appliances onboard? Have the owner or broker operate them. If equipped		
Did the engine start and run well?		
Shift, throttle good?		
Open the engine hatch; look with a flash light, any visible leaks?		
Check all the underwater ball valves for leaks.		
Ensure the engine runs at least an hour during your trip.		
Does all sail gear work as intended?		
Has your gasoline/diesel engine reached close to the maximum RPM?		
Do all electronics work as intended?		
Steering left right, operating smoothly?		
Power trim operable? If equipped		
Trim tabs operable? If equipped		
Generator start/run/supply 120-volt AC to receptacles. If equipped		

Have problems, talk to the seller or your boat broker.
